Good morning –

We have been able to work with Decontamination Decommissioning and Environmental Services [DDES], LLC from Woburn MA to have a Clean-Up Plan and a Cleanup Plan Cost Estimate completed for the property referred to as “Waterbury Clock Company – 7”.

We are in the process of reviewing their documents and discussing them with DDES. Once we have a better understanding of the DDES Clean-Up Plan Cost Estimate we will be able to develop a cost for returning the space to its condition prior to the remediation. We will then be in a position to research potential funding options for the total scope of work.

We will provide the reports to the NRC no later than June 30, 2018.
