Dear Ms. Cook,

With reference to your email dated 25 May 2018, you asked if we would agree with your proposed combination of the radionuclides identified in Items 6.B., 6.H., and 6.I under Item 6.A. in order to simplify the radionuclide authorized use and possession limit information specified on our materials license #42-01368-01.

We still require the increased individual possession limits for iodine-131 (Item 8.H.) and xenon-133 (Item 8.I.) of one (1) curie each.

We no longer require the increased possession limit for hydrogen-3, therefore the associated separate use possession limits information (Items 6.B, 7.B., 8.B, and 9.B) may be removed.
