This letter is to document our telephone conversation earlier this afternoon, regarding the type of license we need.

As I mentioned, Connecticut College is highly unlikely to have the need to possess any radionuclide in quantities greater than allowed in 10 CFR 33.100, Schedule A. Therefore, I'm requesting that our application be amended to file for a Type C Broad Scope License instead of the Type B.
