The Nuclear Regulatory Commission recently published a Federal Register Notice (copy attached) announcing our intent to submit information collection requests to the Office of Management and Budget (OMB) for 10 CFR Part 62, Criteria and Procedures for Emergency Access to Non-Federal and Regional Low-Level Waste Disposal Facilities. A supporting statement describing the requested information and burden estimates are available at <https://regulations.gov> by searching docket NRC-2018-0009.

As a potential respondent to this information collection, we are interested in your feedback. Specifically, we are seeking input on the following questions by June 25, 2018:

1. Is the proposed collection of information necessary for the NRC to properly perform its functions? Does the information have practical utility?
2. Is the burden estimate accurate?
3. Is there a way to enhance the quality, utility, and clarity of the information to be collected?
4. How can the burden of the information collection be minimized, including the use of automated collection techniques or other forms of information technology?
