This letter serves to acknowledge the receipt of Honeywell International, Inc.'s (Honeywell's) June 7, 2018 (Agencywide Documents Access and Management Systems [ADAMS] Accession No. ML18163A133), submittal to the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) requesting the withdrawal of license amendment request (LAR), which was provided to the NRC by letter dated April 30, 2018 (ADAMS Accession Number ML18121A150). Your April 30, 2018, letter requested the removal of License Condition 30 as contained in Honeywell's source materials license, SUB-526, regarding pond closure related activities at the Metropolis Works (MTW) facility.

As you are aware, the NRC staff and Honeywell representatives held a number of discussions related to the surface impound (calcium fluoride) ponds at MTW. In particular, on April 12, 2018 (ADAMS Accession No. ML18113A025), the NRC staff and representatives of Honeywell held a pre-application public meeting to discuss the current pond closure status at Honeywell's MTW facility. Additionally, on May 24 and 31, 2018 (ADAMS Accession No. ML18162A123), the NRC staff and Honeywell representatives held three telephone conferences to discuss the content of the LAR, dated April 30, 2018, in more detail.

The NRC staff has reviewed Honeywell's June 7, 2018, letter for the withdrawal of the April 30, 2018, LAR. As a result, the NRC is closing all staff efforts associated with the review of the April 30, 2018, LAR, under CAC/Docket/EPID No. 000224/04003392/L2018-LLA-0123.
