Dear Ms. Lichtenberg:

In an e-mail and phone call dated May 31, 2018, to the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC), you requested to withdraw Transport Logistics International pending export license application XSOU8834. In response to the e-mail and phone call, the NRC is returning the application to Transport Logistics International without action.

License application XSOU8834 requested the export of 1,800,000 kilograms uranium as natural uranium hexafluoride (UF₆) to China.

As the NRC had already begun processing and reviewing the application, the NRC is unable to refund the \$9,500 licensing fee that Transport Logistics International submitted to the NRC on March 28, 2014.
