REPLY AND OBECTION TO MOTION TO DISMISS

The Plaintiff hereby objects to the Defendant’s Motion to Dismiss, filed on June 1st, 2018, on the following grounds: The Plaintiff believes that the Nuclear Regulatory Commission had a reasonable obligation to inform him about how to appeal its final decision.
