The State of New Hampshire, the Commonwealth of Massachusetts and Local Emergency Response Organizations successfully demonstrated their capabilities to implement off-site radiological emergency response plans and procedures based on the evaluation of this exercise by a team of Federal evaluators with final determinations made by the Regional Assistance Committee Chairperson. There were No Level 1 or Level 2 Findings and No Planning Issues identified for the State of New Hampshire and the Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

State and local preparedness remains adequate to protect the health and safety of the public living in the vicinity of the Seabrook Nuclear Power Station and provides reasonable assurance that appropriate measures can be taken off-site in the event of a radiological emergency.
