Good morning, Mr. Eagle.

I spoke to Elisa, the Administrative Assistant in your office this morning who indicated that I should email any materials concerning the work of the Tribal Historic Preservation Office for your review when you returned to the office.

I am a member of the tribal liaison team at the U. S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) in Washington. I am sending information today on behalf of the NRC's Agreement State Program. This program allows a state to take over regulation of some nuclear materials, if the state develops a program that is approved by the NRC. The State of Wyoming has submitted an application to the NRC to have a program to regulate uranium mill facilities within their borders. The NRC is preparing a letter to send to your Chairman with a copy to you, explaining more about the application and the program.

In the meantime, I wanted to let you know that the State of Wyoming has published the rules that will govern this program on the State's website for comments. The state is accepting comments until May 1st. Attached to this email is an announcement from the State of Wyoming that provides the websites for the rules and for the submission of any comments.

Also attached is a fact sheet and questions and answers on the NRC Agreement State Program and WY's application. If you have any questions regarding the NRC Agreement State Program or the Wyoming application, please contact Mr. Duncan White, Senior Technical Advisor, @ (301)415-2598 or Duncan.White@nrc.gov who would be happy to provide additional information.

In addition to the forthcoming letter, the agency is considering developing a webinar on the Agreement state program and the status of the agreement state process for Wyoming. Should the agency develop this webinar, we will be in touch again to provide the date.
