Enclosed is a copy of the **final** revision to the Alabama Radiation Control Rule 420-3-26-.15, Physical Protection of Category 1 and Category 2 Quantities of Radioactive Material. The **proposed** revisions were submitted to your office by letter dated February 13, 2018. The final regulations are identified by underline/strike-out and correspond to the following equivalent amendments to NRC's regulations. This rule has an effective date of July 2, 2018.

We believe that adoption of these revisions satisfies the compatibility and health and safety categories established in the Office of Nuclear Material Safety and Safeguards (NMSS) Procedure SA-200.

In response to your letter dated April 27, 2018, Rule 420-3-26-.15(10)(c)1. was amended to replace the name "Office of Resources Management" with "Office of the Chief Information Officer." Unfortunately, a similar change cannot be made at this time to our Rule 420-3-26-.03, Appendix G since that section of our rules was not part of this rule packet revision. The item will be addressed the next time amendments are made to Rule 420-3-26-.03, Standards for Protection Against Radiation. We appreciate you bringing this item to our attention.
