Dear Ms. Janzow:

This letter refers to an investigation conducted by the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC), Office of Investigations (OI) to determine if you, the President of the Frontier Technology Corporation (FTC), deliberately exported radioactive material to an embargoed country without a specific NRC license. Additionally, this investigation was initiated to determine if you, or any employee of the FTC, deliberately failed to notify the NRC of information as having a significant implication for public health and safety or common defense and security. Based on the evidence developed during the OI investigation, the NRC could not substantiate that wrongdoing occurred.

Please note that the complete OI investigation report, including supporting documentation, may be obtained by you and the public under the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA), subject to redaction of information pursuant to the FOIA. Requests under the FOIA should be made in accordance with Title 10 of the *Code of Federal Regulations* (10 CFR) 9.23, "Requests for Records."
