We request the following amendment to Tripler Army Medical Center's (TAMC's) NRC License #53-00458-04 Amendment 97.

Please specifically list Lutetium-177 under paragraph 6, with a corresponding paragraph 7 (Chemical and/or physical form) of "Any Except Sealed Sources", paragraph 8 (Maximum amount that licensee may possess at any one time under this license) of 500 mCi, and paragraph 9 (Authorized use) of "For use in medical diagnosis, therapy, and research in humans. Research and development as defined in 10 CFR 30.4, including: animal studies; instrument calibration; and in-vitro studies." Lutathera is a radiopharmaceutical used to treat adults with a type of cancer known as gastroenteropancreatic neuroendocrine cancers in the abdomen. The prescribed Lutathera dose is 200 mCi Lu-177 every eight weeks for four doses. Thus, the 100 mCi per source limit covered by paragraph 6.A. of our current license is insufficient to cover the use of Lutathera.

Please delete "CHP" from line item 11.A. The "CHP" is a suffix inadvertently left over from the previous license amendment.

Request changing the License name in paragraph 1 from "Department of the Army, Commander, Tripler Army Medical Center" to "Department of the Army, Tripler Army Medical Center".
