Dear NRC Staff,

As a Tennessee student, I am very interested about constructive innovations, TVA's early site permit application for small modular reactors at the Clinch River Site in Tennessee potentially being one of them. Although I do not, yet, reside in East Tennessee, NRC should evaluate the costs of SMRs in comparison to other energy choices, such as wind and solar, including energy efficiency, conservation and miscellaneous bleeding edge technologies that have the potential of being more holistic.

A comparison of the impacts on our water resources, including water quality and water supply of both surface and groundwater, should also be done by the NRC for SMRs and these other energy choices. If TVA could display regenerative and/or holistic byproducts from their experimental technologies, our communities would be more receptive of their endeavors.

Last, I request that the NRC reject TVA's effort to reduce the emergency planning zone from 10-miles to 2 miles or less. Should an accident ever occur at the Clinch River Site, the NRC should provide the public with a detailed analysis of how many members of the public could be harmed if these changes in the safety radius are implemented. The safety of our communities should be the NRC's top concern, not the ability for utilities to pursue an experimental technology that is not needed.
