**NOTIFICATION OF TERMINATION OF LICENSE USE AT THE
FORMER MARE ISLAND NAVAL SHIPYARD, VALLEJO,
CALIFORNIA**

To Whom it May Concern:

Radiological Survey & Remedial Services LLC (RSRS) has concluded performing certain activities at the Former Mare Island Naval Shipyard, in Vallejo, California under the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) Radioactive Materials License listed above. In accordance with license condition 10, RSRS concluded activities under our license on June 8, 2018.

RSRS provided initial notification of our license activities to the California Department of Public Health, Radiological Health Branch and to the U.S. NRC Region IV on May 19, 2018 for activities beginning on June 4, 2018.


The activities RSRS performed were limited to health physics support services during a radiological survey of the South Shore Area at the Former Mare Island Naval Shipyard. No radioactive materials were identified during the survey work.

Pursuant to license condition 13, RSRS entered into a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with Weston Solutions to delineate license responsibilities. A request to terminate the MOU was executed June 28, 2018, which is still pending due to the availability of Weston's RSO.
