General Comment

It is irresponsible for the NRC to dismiss the question of exemptions for lead test assemblies (LTAs) without having performed any evaluation to determine a finding of no significant impact. Without any environmental assessment, the NRC improperly ignores all questions related to the proposed actions having significant effect on the quality of the human environment. The NRC position also deprives the public of litigation rights under the exemption process.

I request the NRC hold a public meeting to discuss the resolution of public comments including those submitted by Mr. Harold Chernoff of NRC and those of another NRC employee that submitted a differing professional opinion (DPO). The NRC should not finalize its positions until after the public meeting.
