Hello,

Thank you for the opportunity to comment on the draft letter to the Nuclear Energy Institute regarding clarification of regulatory paths for lead test assemblies. I'm just a regular citizen with no scientific background, but I oppose unreviewed and unapproved fuel tests in the nuclear power plants.

It seems too dangerous to set aside federal regulations to permit nuclear plant owners to experiment with new fuel pellets and fuel rods in the nuclear power reactors in our neighborhoods without prior NRC review and approval, and without people living near the plants having a chance to agree or disagree with the experiment.
