By letter dated June 13, 2012 (Reference 1), Tennessee Valley Authority (TVA) provided a list of commitments to the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) related to TVA's updated hydrologic analysis for Sequoyah Nuclear Plant, Units 1 and 2, and Watts Bar Nuclear Plant, Unit 1. On June 25, 2012, the NRC issued a Confirmatory Action Letter (Reference 2) to TVA regarding these commitments. The Reference 2 letter requires TVA to notify the NRC in writing when all of the actions addressed in the Confirmatory Action Letter have been completed.

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The Reference 3 letter included the complete list of the required commitments and noted that all of the commitments were completed, with the exception of Commitment 14, i.e., the modification to the Fort Loudon Dam. Also in Reference 3, TVA notified the NRC of a change to the completion date of the Fort Loudoun Dam (Commitment 14) to June 30, 2018.

With the completion of the Fort Loudoun Dam modifications on May 22, 2018, TVA has completed all of the actions in the Confirmatory Action Letter.
