As a citizen who lives near one of the nation's nuclear plants in Seabrook, NH, it concerns me deeply to think about hundreds of thousands of tons of nuclear waste being moved around the country and placed "temporarily" in sensitive lands near vulnerable low-income and minority populations in New Mexico.
