Discuss declared proprietary information in license renewal application

SUMMARY

TN Americas: Don Shaw (TN Americas)

NRC attendees: Meraj Rahimi (Chief, Renewals and Materials Branch), Wendy Reed (Chemist)

A teleconference was held between NRC and TN Americas representatives to discuss the declared proprietary information in the Rancho Seco ISFSI license renewal application.

The purpose of the call was to: (1) communicate the status of the NRC's proprietary review; (2) establish why the proprietary determination was made for a number of INPO report titles included in the license renewal application.

NRC informed Don Shaw that the proprietary review was ongoing and asked why certain report titles has been designated proprietary. Mr. Shaw responded that one of the titles is descriptive of another cask vendor and that INPO specifics have typically been withheld. In the application, one of the titles was erroneously not included in the proprietary determination. Mr. Shaw also stated that TN Americas would not have an objection to the NRC finding that all the titles should be publicly available.
