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| 1 | LAND USE - ABOUT 70% WOODLAND, 20% PASTURE, AND 10% CROPLAND. TOPOGRAPHY - BROAD TO NARROW GENTLY SLOPING RIDGETOPS DISSECTED BY MANY SHALLOW DRAINS. |
| 2 | LAND USE - ABOUT 85% WOODLAND, 10% PASTURE, AND 5% CROPLAND. TOPOGRAPHY - DISSECTED SHORT, NARROW TO MEDIUM RIDGETOPS WITH STEEP SIDE SLOPES ADJACENT TO MANY MEDIUM-SIZED DRAINS AND A FEW MAJOR DRAINAGEWAYS. |
| 3 | LAND USE - ABOUT 80% WOODLAND, 10% PASTURE, 5% CROPLAND, AND 5% IN RESIDENTIAL DEVELOPMENT. TOPOGRAPHY - BROAD, GENTLY SLOPING TO NEARLY LEVEL RIDGETOPS WITH A FEW SMALL SHALLOW DRAINS. |
| 4 | LAND USE - ABOUT 75% CROPLAND, 20% WOODLAND, AND 5% PASTURE. TOPOGRAPHY - BROAD, GENTLY SLOPING RIDGETOPS CUT BY MANY SHALLOW DRAINS. |
| 5 | LAND USE - ABOUT 45% WOODLAND, 35% PASTURE, 15% CROPLAND, AND 5% IN RESIDENTIAL DEVELOPMENT. TOPOGRAPHY - BROAD, MODERATELY DISSECTED RIDGETOPS. |
| 6 | LAND USE - ABOUT 75% WOODLAND, 20% PASTURE, AND 5% CROPLAND. TOPOGRAPHY - NEARLY LEVEL STREAM BOTTOMLAND AND ADJACENT SLOPING TERRACES. |
