Response: Premium Inspection and Testing, Inc. (14950 Heathrow Forest Parkway, Suite 370 Houston, Texas 77032) will acquire Quality Testing Services Inc. (2305 Millpark Drive St Louis Missouri 63043) through a 100% stock purchase. Premium Inspection & Testing Inc. will retain the legal entity of Quality Testing Services, Inc. Premium Inspection and Testing, Inc. is structured to include multiple operating divisions including Capitol Ultrasonics LLC (8225 Florida Blvd Baton Rouge, Louisiana 70806 and 2717 Ruby Avenue Gonzales, Louisiana 70737), Quad City Testing Laboratory, Inc. (21112 Scott Park Road Davenport, Iowa 52807) and Quad City Testing, Inc. (960 N Dupage Avenue Lombard, Illinois 60148). Quality Testing Services, Inc. will operate as an independent division known as Premium Inspection and Testing Inc, Quality Testing Services Division.

2. Describe any changes in personnel or duties that relate to the licensed program. Include training and experience for new personnel and changes in the training program.

Response: There will be no changes in licensed program related to Premium Inspection & Testing, Inc., Quality Testing Services Division personnel or their current duties. The training program will remain as currently utilized.

3. Describe any changes in location, facilities, equipment, radiation safety program, use, possession, waste management, or other procedures that relate to the licensed program.

Response: There will be no changes in location (2305 Millpark Drive St Louis, Missouri 63043), facilities, equipment, radiation safety program, use, possession, waste management, or other licensed related procedures at this division.

4. Describe the status of the licensee's facilities, equipment, radiation safety program, including known contamination and whether decontamination will occur prior to transfer. Include the status of calibrations, leak tests, area surveys, wipe tests, training, quality control, and related records.

Response: The facilities will remain as currently approved. The 2305 Millpark Drive St Louis, Missouri facility operates as a temporary job site with licensed activity performed at both this location and various customer sites in the course of conducting radiographic operations. There will be no change in the current operational facility, equipment, or radiation safety program. There is no known contamination at this facility and only sealed radioactive material sources are utilized. There is no need



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for decontamination nor will any be conducted. All operating equipment calibrations, leak tests, training, and area surveys are current and up to date.

5. If current decommissioning funding plans (DFP) will be changed as a result of the transfer, the revised DFP should be submitted. If other financial assurance documents will be changed as a result of the transfer, confirm that all financial assurance instruments associated with license will be held in the transferee's name before license is transferred, and as required by 10 CFR 30.35(f), the licensee must, within 30 days, submit financial instruments reflecting such changes.

Response: The decommissioning funding plan will not be changed due to the transfer. This submittal confirms that all financial assurance instruments associated with the license will be held in the transferee's name prior to the license transfer as per 10 CFR 30.35(f). The licensee will submit all required financial instruments reflecting this change within 30 days.

6. Confirm that all records concerning the safe and effective decommissioning of the facility will be transferred to the transferee or to the NRC, as appropriate. These records include documentation of surveys of ambient radiation levels and fixed and/or removable contamination, including methods and sensitivity.

Response: The facility will continue as currently operating and decommissioning is not required. All license related records currently mandated and maintained by Quality Testing Services, Inc. will be transferred to the new ownership. These records will continue to be maintained on file at the 2305 Millpark Drive St Louis, Missouri facility.

7. Confirm that both the transferor and transferee agree to transferring control of the licensed material and activity, and the conditions of transfer, and that the transferee has been made aware of any open inspection items and its responsibility for possible resulting enforcement action.

Response: A purchase agreement has been negotiated confirming the agreement of transfer of control of all licensed material and activity and will be executed at closing of the transaction. This includes the conditions of the transfer. A complete due diligence of all open inspection items (none) has been conducted.

8. Confirm that transferee will abide by all constraints, conditions, requirements, representations, and commitments of the transferor or that the transferee will submit a complete description of the proposed licensed program.

Response: All license-related activity, including constraints, conditions, requirements, representations, and commitments of the transferor, Quality Testing Services, Inc., will be abided by the transferee,



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Premium Inspection & Testing Inc. and its Divisions Capitol Ultrasonics, LLC, Quad City Testing Laboratory, Inc. and Quality Testing Services, Inc. All license-related activity conducted at this or any other NRC nonagreement State will be conducted utilizing the radiation safety program, use, possession, waste management and other related procedures currently utilized by the transferor.


