I am an environmental scientist performing an environmental due diligence evaluation for a property with an address of 1151 W. Elm Avenue, Monroe, MI 48162 (Monroe County). As a part of my work, I review an environmental database. The database included information indicating this property was previously licensed by the Nuclear Regulatory Commission. No precise information was provided in the database on why a license was acquired, for what purpose, etc. The database information is limited to the following:

License number: 21-32092-01  
First license date: 5/21/1998  
License expiration date: 5/31/2008  
License holder: IKO Monroe, Inc.  
Institution code: 32092  
Last inspection date: 11/1/1998

For your information, my understanding is that IKO Monroe, Inc. is roofing materials manufacturer (e.g. insulation, shingles).

I am sending this email as a Freedom of Information Act request to obtain further information or guidance on how to obtain information on the license history, radioactive use type, quantities, where used, etc. I need to make an informed opinion about whether the radioactive license operations represent a concern to a property purchaser.
