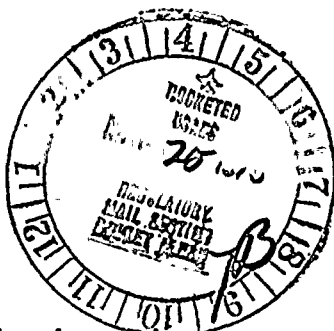

Proposed Changes in Technical Specifications

In accordance with 10 CFR 50.30, Florida Power & Light Company submits herewith three (3) signed originals and forty (40) copies of a request to amend Appendix A of the Facility Operating License DPR-31 and 41.

The changes are as set forth in the attached revised pages of the Technical Specifications bearing this date and supersede the changes proposed in our letter of September 6, 1974.

The changes proposed on the attached pages are being submitted so that the Technical Specifications will conform to the ECCS Final Acceptance Criteria as described in the FSAR via Supplements 59 and 63 and with the requirements of the Order for Modification of License issued December 27, 1974.

In accordance with directives pertaining to the Final Acceptance Criteria for ECCS, these Technical Specifications have been implemented, except for changes submitted February 10, 1975, relating to Unit 4, Cycle 2, and the change in Section 3.2.6.j(1) of this submittal where we have relaxed the requirement for taking a full in-core detector map by reducing the fuel assembly detector thimble surveillance from 40 to 36. This change will still provide a representative sample of neutron flux throughout the core without involving any significant hazards considerations, while reducing the probability of not being able to meet a limiting condition for operation. However, until we have received approval of this change, we will continue to take full movable in-core detector maps with a minimum of 40 fuel assembly detector thimbles.

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


