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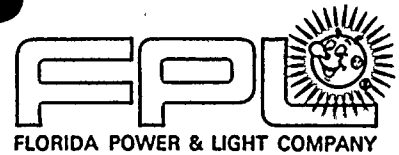

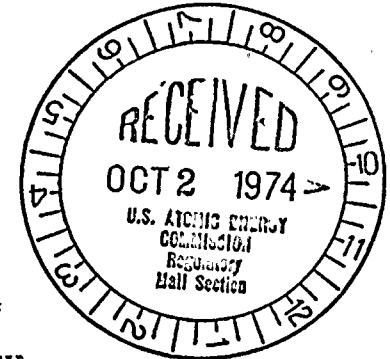
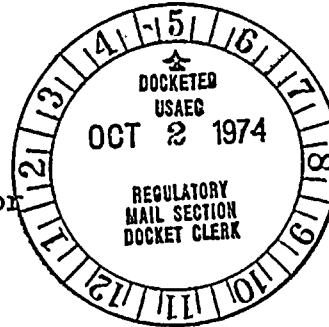

TURKEY POINT PLANT UNITS 3 AND 4
DOCKET NOS. 50-250 AND 50-251
PROPOSED AMENDMENT TO THE FACILITY
OPERATING LICENSES DPR-31 AND DPR-41

In accordance with 10 CFR 50.30, Florida Power & Light Company submits herewith three signed originals and forty (40) conformed copies of a request to amend the Facility Operating Licenses DPR-31 and DPR-41.

This submittal supplements our September 6, 1974 submittal in which we proposed changes to the Technical Specifications (Appendix A of the Facility Operating Licenses) implementing the ECCS Final Acceptance Criteria (FAC).

We are submitting this request based on additional information which Florida Power & Light Company received from the reactor vendor concerning the FAC analyses. These analyses show that the safety injection system accumulator water volume must be increased from the present minimum of 775 cubic feet to 825 cubic feet. We have not changed the present Technical Specification accumulator water volume difference of 16 cubic feet between the lower and upper Technical Specification limits, therefore, the upper limit must be increased to 841 cubic feet. However, this volume difference is subject to change following further review and analysis.


To fully comply with the FAC analyses we are requesting the above mentioned changes to the attached revised Page 3.4-1 of the Technical Specifications (Appendix A of the Facility Operating Licenses). As we have already implemented the Technical Specification changes submitted on September 6, 1974, this change will be implemented by October 1, 1974.




