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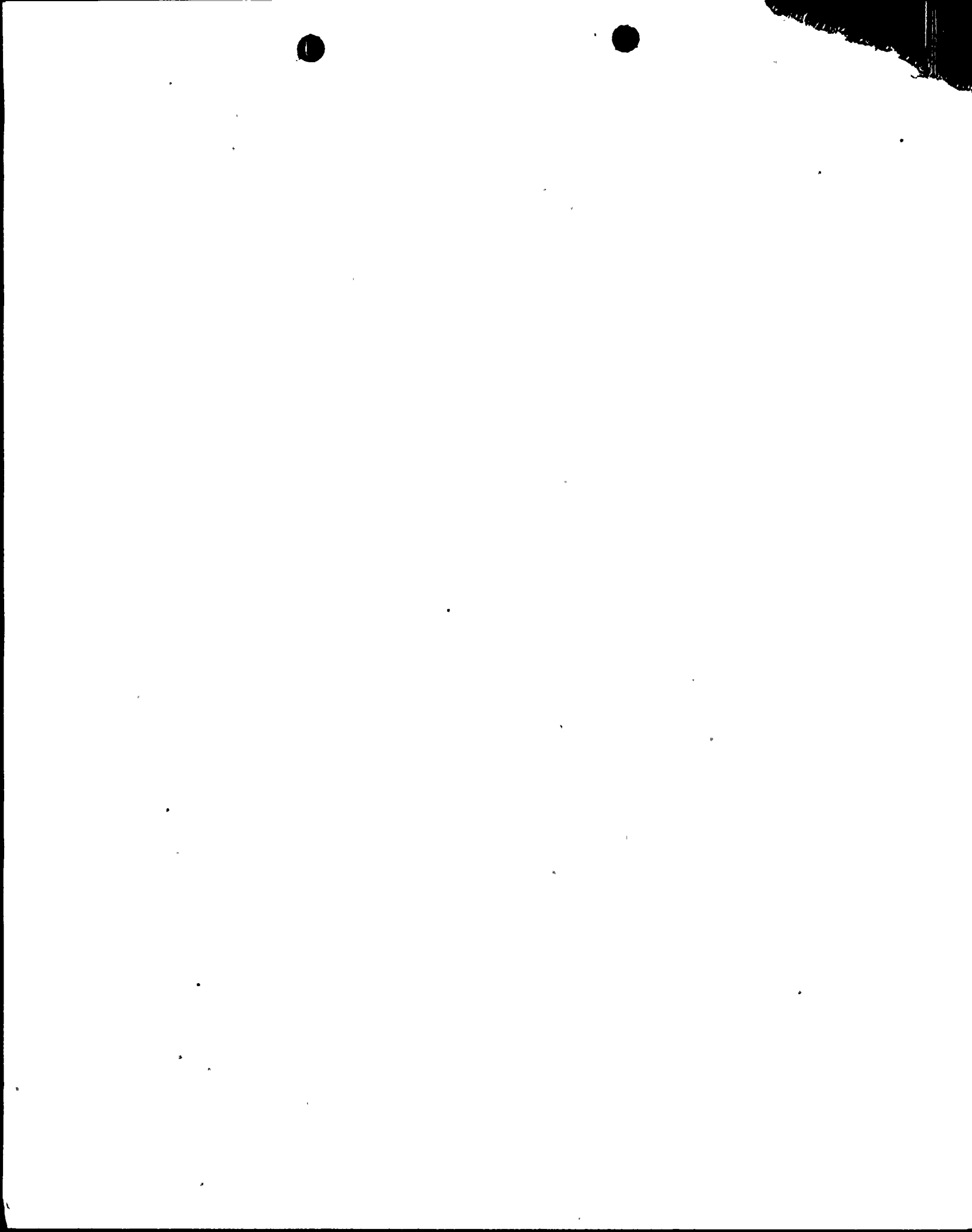

By letters dated September 7, 1976 (L-76-323) and October 5, 1976 (L-76-350) Florida Power & Light Company (FPL) proposed changes to the Turkey Point Plant Environmental Technical Specifications (ETS). Your staff has requested additional information which is enclosed as Attachment 1 and is incorporated in a revised version of the ETS (Attachment 2).

The revised version of the ETS (Attachment 2) includes a rewritten Section 4.0 which clearly delineates the objective, monitoring requirements, reporting requirements, and bases for each specification. This rewritten section retains all of the requirements of Section 4.0 as presented previously (except changes already discussed with your staff); only the format and wording are changed in order to improve ease of implementation and verification.

Attachment 2 includes bars in the right hand margin to indicate changes from our submittal of October 5, 1976 as modified by our letter of February 23, 1977. These changes have been reviewed and approved by the Florida Power & Light Company Environmental Review Group and Company Nuclear Review Board. They have determined that the changes do not impact the environmental assessment of the licensed facility, and do not affect the health and safety of the public.
