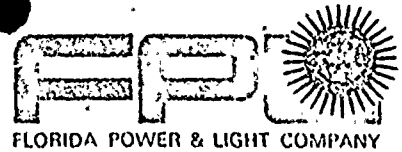

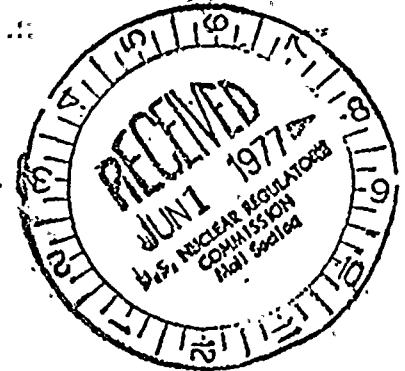

Enclosed herewith are four (4) copies of Revision 12 to the Turkey Point Security Plan, numbered MCD-15-(1-4). This revision is submitted in response to new rule 10 CFR 73.55, as published in the Federal Register on February 24, 1977, (FR10836).

We are forwarding a copy, number MCD-15-5, to the Region II Office of Inspection and Enforcement.

In light of additional NRC Staff guidance received May 23, 1977, relative to the physical search required by 10 CFR 73.55 (d) (1). Florida Power & Light has revised its position on that subject. However, we were unable to address the revised plan to this guidance within the established time constraints. Therefore, within 14 days of the date of this letter, a "hands-on" search program will be instituted in accordance with your Staff's guidance. Appropriate revisions will be made to the Security Plan upon completion of your review of the entire plan.

The following two items will be completed by August 24, 1978, in accordance with 10 CFR 73.55 provision for requirements involving construction and installation of equipment:

- 1) Vital area barrier protection will be provided for the 3A and 4A 480 V MCC.
- 2) The control room doors will be replaced to meet the requirement for bullet resisting construction.

Also enclosed as Attachment 1 to this letter is our response to items 2, 3, and 4 of Mr. George Lear's letter of April 5, 1977. A response to item 1 was submitted by our letter of May 6, 1977, (L-77-140).

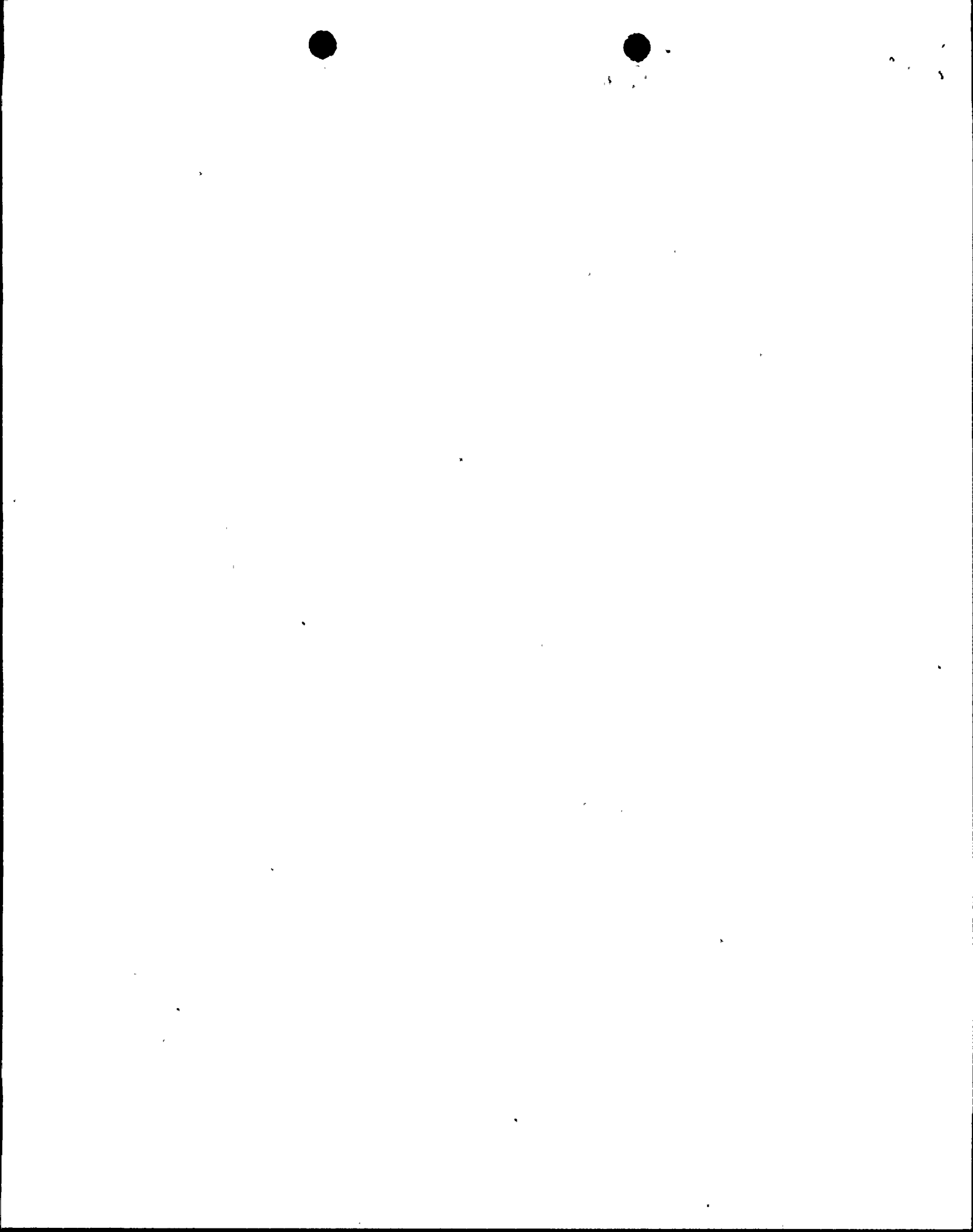

ATTACHMENT 1

RESPONSE TO LETTER, WITH ENCLOSURE, OF MR. GEORGE LEAR DATED APRIL 5, 1977

Item 2 requested clarification of the policy permitting the Plant Manager or his designated representative to permit personally owned vehicles to park inside the Protected Area. The intent of this policy is to permit action in the event of emergency conditions such as actual or potential violence or severe weather conditions to include high water. Maintenance of employee transportation in emergency conditions contributes to the safe operation of the plant.

Item 3 questioned the removal of the requirement for having a member of the Security Force control access to security controlled areas. The Security Force member was assigned to monitor an alarm console which was replaced by a new alarm system, now located in the south security station. Reference Chapter 6.

Item 4 requested justification for the removal of the requirement that an escort be identified and qualified: Reference Chapter 4.5.
