The Auxiliary Building for the licensee's Turkey Point Nuclear Generating Unit No. 3 located about 25 miles south of Miami in Dade County, Florida. The Auxiliary Building is indicated by a heavy line on Figure 1.2-3 attached hereto, and made a part hereof.

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The Auxiliary Building for the licensee's Turkey Point Nuclear Generating Unit No. 3 and the fuel handling structure for the licensee's Turkey Point Nuclear Generating Unit No. 4 both located about 25 miles south of Miami in Dade County, Florida. The Auxiliary Building and the fuel handling structure are indicated by heavy lines on Figure 1.2-3 attached hereto, and made a part hereof.

All the premises, including the land and all buildings and structures, known as the Florida Power and Light Company's Turkey Point Power Station except the portions of said station which are used exclusively in connection with the operation of conventionally (fossil) fueled Units Nos. 1 and 2. The location is delineated by a red line on Figure 5610-SK-C-267, attached hereto and made a part hereof. The Turkey Point Power Station is located on the shore of Biscayne Bay approximately twenty-five (25) miles south of Miami, Florida.



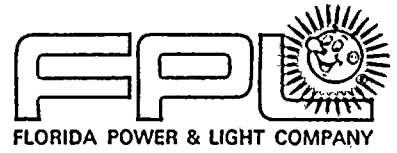

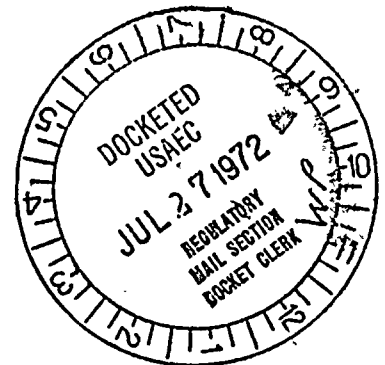
