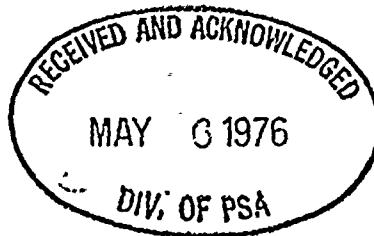

It should also be brought to your attention that you are running for re-election and to get votes you must do what the people want! So I think it would be smart to look into this small but important situation.

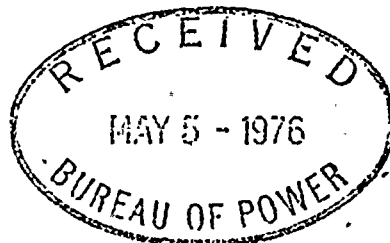
