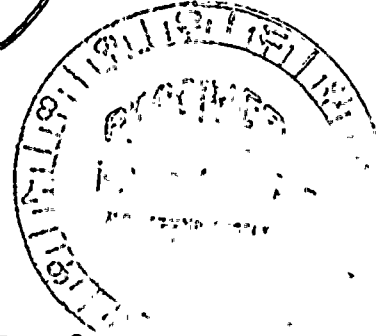

units.

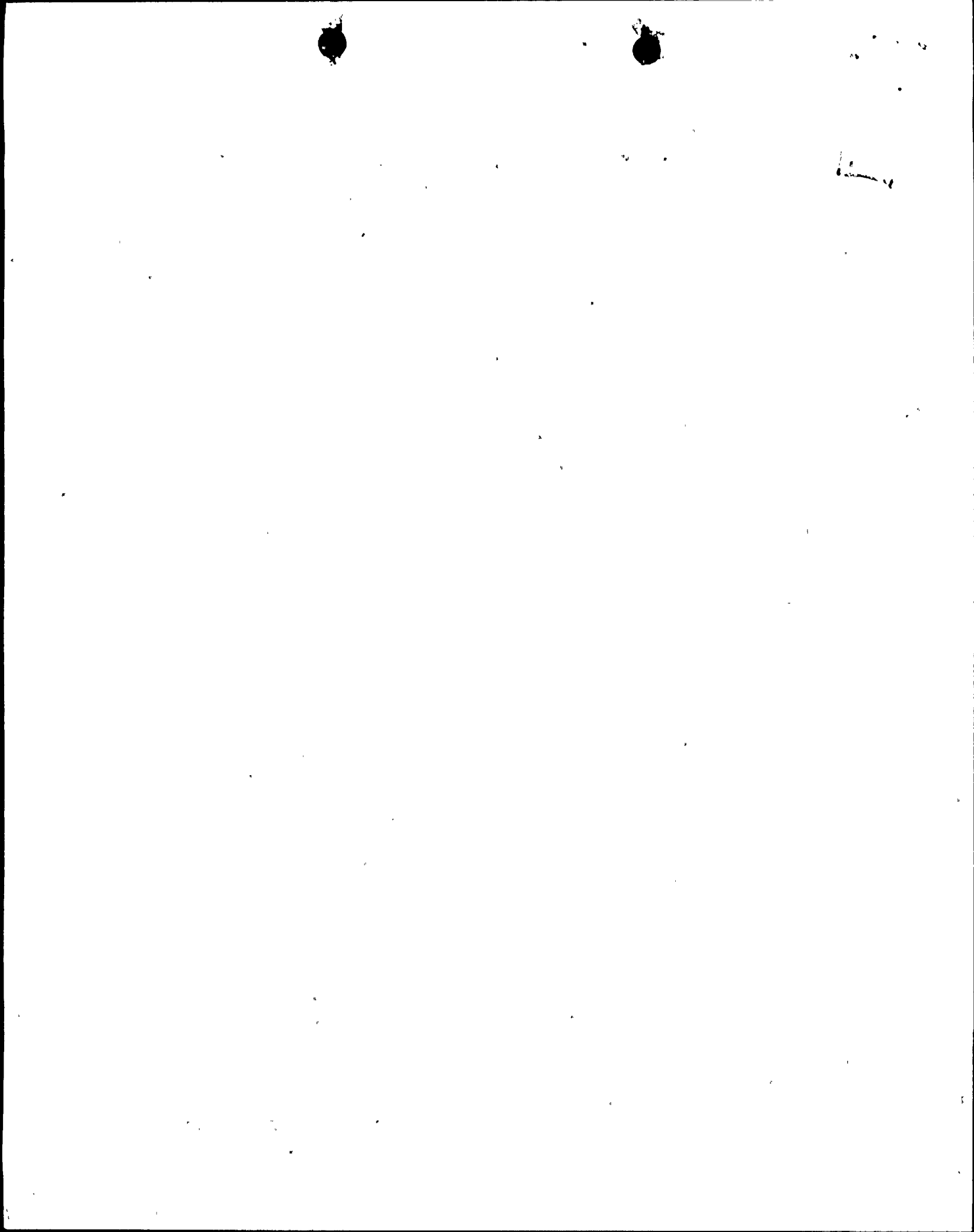

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Amendment to Indemnity Agreement No. B-46

Amendment No. 8

Effective April 14, 1975, Indemnity Agreement No. B-46 dated August 4, 1970, between Florida Power & Light Company and the Nuclear Regulatory Commission as amended, is hereby further amended as follows:

Item 4 - Location is deleted and replaced by the following site location description:

Item-4-Location-

All of the premises including the land, all buildings and structures of Units 3 & 4 of Turkey Point Power Station designated as the "nuclear area" on drawing PA-2, attached hereto and made a part hereof. The Turkey Point Power Station is located on the shores of Biscayne Bay approximately twenty-five (25) miles south of Miami, Florida.



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
