**LICENSEE:**

The inspection was an examination of the activities conducted under your license as they relate to radiation safety and to compliance with the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) rules and regulations and the conditions of your license. The inspection consisted of selective examinations of procedures and representative records, interviews with personnel, and observations by the inspector. The inspection findings are as follows:

- 1. Based on the inspection findings, no violations were identified.
- 2. Previous violation(s) closed.
- 3. The violation(s), specifically described to you by the inspector as non-cited violations, are not being cited because they were self-identified, non-repetitive, and corrective action was or is being taken, and the remaining criteria in the NRC Enforcement Policy, to exercise discretion, were satisfied.

Non-cited violation(s) were discussed involving the following requirement(s) and corrective action(s):

- 4. During this inspection, certain of your activities, as described below and/or attached, were in violation of NRC requirements and are being cited in accordance with the NRC Enforcement Policy. 10 CFR 20.1101(c) requires licensees to periodically (at least annually) review the radiation protection program content and implementation.




Contrary to the above, Belt Paving, Inc. did not periodically (at least annually) review the radiation protection program content and implementation. Specifically, the licensee did not perform annual reviews of the radiation protection program for the years 2015, 2016, and 2017.

This is a Severity Level IV violation (Section 6.3)

The Radiation Safety Officer stated that he would initiate an annual audit on June 26, 2018, and committed to place the requirement for conducting and documenting an annual audit on an electronic scheduling calendar. The corrective action will be evaluated during a future inspection of the licensee's program.

**Statement of Corrective Actions**

I hereby state that, within 30 days, the actions described by me to the Inspector will be taken to correct the violations identified. This statement of corrective actions is made in accordance with the requirements of 10 CFR 2.201 (corrective steps already taken, corrective steps which will be taken, date when full compliance will be achieved).
