Dear Dr. Caspers:

In NRC Form 314 dated May 21, 2018 (ML18142B593), you contacted the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission and indicated that you wished to terminate NRC License No. 21-00241-09. In that letter, you provided information confirming that all residual licensed material from University of Detroit Mercy had been removed from its Detroit, Michigan campus, listed on the referenced license – such that any remaining residual radioactivity is within the limits of Title 10 of the *Code of Federal Regulations* Part 20, subpart E, and is ALARA.

Based on its review, the staff has concluded that all licensable radioactive material has been removed from the University of Detroit Mercy, 4001 W McNichols Rd., Detroit, Michigan and residual radioactive material attributable to licensed activities does not exceed current NRC criteria. Based on these conclusions no further remediation or actions with respect to NRC regulated material are required. Your facilities are suitable for unrestricted use and NRC license number 21-00241-09 is hereby terminated.
