Current and Future Partnerships Between SDOs

- Joint efforts like the Advanced Reactor Workshop held in May 2018 can be useful for identifying areas where we need to work together
- Formal liaisons can help the flow of information
- Setting up of joint standards committees such as the JCNRM, where needed, is very effective
- Dual Logo Standards can be very effective when usage supports the effort

Current and Future Partnerships Between SDOs, Industry and Government

- Partnerships are needed to ensure that the SDOs are working on the most important issues
- Can facilitate developing and identifying possible new members for Standard Committees, particularly young members
- A liaison program should be as formal as possible to ensure coordination is continuous
- Liaisons can alert senior management of issues and needs.
- Partnerships can ensure new ideas find a home and are worked at the needed level of priority
