On August 9, 2018, I notified you by email that the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) staff had published on the NRC's public website, information related to its draft cultural resource sections regarding Cameco Resources' proposed license renewal for the Smith Ranch-Highland Uranium Project per Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act. As stated in the August 9th email and on the website, the NRC staff is soliciting comments on the document that is accessible by the link provided on the web page.
