Dear Ms. Beardsley,

The Vermont Department of Health has revised its rule for the regulation of radioactive materials to reflect comments obtained during the rulemaking process here in Vermont. We are preparing to take the revised rule to the Legislative Committee on Administrative Rules for further rulemaking activity. As discussed previously, we wanted to share the rule as revised for public comment with the Nuclear Regulatory Commission at this stage.

As can be seen in the attached tracked changes and clean versions of the Radioactive Materials Rule, the regulation is strictly written only for the purposes of Vermont's Application to Become an Agreement State and the assumption of regulatory authority over specific uses of radioactive materials in the State of Vermont. You will also see revisions discussed by the NRC and the Vermont Department of Health before we went through the 60-day public comment period.

Our goal is to use your prompt review as we move on in both the rulemaking process here in Vermont and prepare our final formal Application to Become an Agreement State.
