The U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) is publishing the following document in the *Federal Register*:

- Title: "Amendments to Agency Procedure for Responding to Adverse Court Rulings and Agency Procedure for Addressing Funding Shortfalls" [Docket Nos. PRM-2-15; NRC-2015-0264].
- Description of the document: This document informs the public that the NRC will not consider in the rulemaking process the issues raised in a petition for rulemaking (PRM), PRM-2-15, submitted by Mr. Jeffrey M. Skov (petitioner). The petitioner requested that the NRC amend its regulations to establish procedures for (1) responding to adverse court decisions, and (2) annually reporting to the public each instance where the NRC does not receive sufficient funds reasonably necessary to implement in good faith its statutory mandates. The NRC is denying the petition because the petitioner did not identify shortcomings in the NRC'S current regulations, or demonstrated a need for the requested changes.
- Dates: The docket for PRM-2-15 is closed upon publication in the *Federal Register*.
