Dear Mr. Neal Weitman,

This is in reference to your letter dated August 15, 2018, requesting for amendment to Nuclear Regulatory Commission License No. 31-31412-01, Docket No. 03038306. In order to continue our review, we need the following additional information:

1. You have submitted for a change of control using NUREG-1556, Volume 15, Rev. 1, Appendix E. The information given did not fully describe the changes that have taken place between Ammann & Whitney, Inc. (A&W) and Louis Berger U.S., Inc(LBUS). In a public announcement it stated that the companies were integrated on July 2, 2016. However, in your letter you stated that A&W still conducts business in the northeast. Please provide a diagram of ownership of A&W and LBUS before July 2, 2016, and after July 2, 2016. As stated in the NUREG-1556, Volume 15, Rev 1., please describe any planned changes in the organization, including but not limited to, transfer of stocks or assets and mergers, change in members on Board of Directors, etc
2. Based upon your letter, it appears that LBUS will obtain direct control over the license and that this change may have already occurred. Please state when this occurred, or if it has not occurred, please state when it is scheduled to occur.
3. In item 3 of your letter, you requested for the removal of your facility at 430 New Park Avenue, West Hartford, Connecticut. As stated in NUREG-1757, Volume 1, "Consolidated Decommissioning Guidance: Decommissioning Process for Materials Licensees," please provide a copy of the last leak test for any device stored at the 430 New Park Avenue facility.

We will continue our review upon receipt of this information. Please reply to my attention at the Region 1 Office (Address below) and refer to Mail Control No. 609703. If you have technical questions regarding this letter, please call me at (610) 337-5366.

Your reply must be an originally signed and dated letter. The letter may be scanned and submitted as a pdf document attached to an email; or it may be transmitted by facsimile to (610) 337-5269; or it may be sent by regular mail. If we do not receive a reply from you within 30 calendar days from the date of this e-mail, we will assume that you do not wish to pursue your application OR amendment request.
