Dear Dr. Amurao:

This refers to a letter dated July 27, 2018 notifying the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) of your intention to cease principal activities at Olin Residence Hall, 4550 Scott Avenue, St. Louis, Missouri, under License No. 24-00167-11 (Mail Control Number 609670). You notified the NRC in accordance with Title 10 of the *Code of Federal Regulations* (CFR) 30.36(d)(2).

In accordance with 10 CFR 30.36(d), you can begin decommissioning so that the building is suitable for release in accordance with NRC requirements (see chapters 4 and 5 of NUREG-1757, Vol. 2, Rev. 1, "Consolidated Decommissioning Guidance") or submit within 12 months of notification a decommissioning plan, if required by 10 CFR 30.36(g)(1).

When a licensee permanently ceases principal activities at a building, outdoor area or site, the NRC considers the facility to transition from operational to decommissioning, for fee-billing purposes, and the fees you will be assessed may change. Please contact the NRC to discuss your plans to decommission your site and the impacts it will have on your fee-billing.
