Dear Mr. Rowden:


I am writing in regard to the need of having the Tennessee Valley Authority be permitted to load the fuel in the Brown's Ferry Nuclear Plant, Units One and Two, and test and operate these units pending completion of the evidentiary hearing.

I understand that the repairs to Units One and Two have been made under the close supervision of the Nuclear Regulatory Agency and that a long period of time has passed with no action being taken to put this plant back into operation. If all the safety factors are present in this plant, I feel that it should be placed in operation as soon as possible.

I would appreciate it if you would look into this matter and let me know when action on this reopening may be taken.
