REQUEST FOR ADDITIONAL INFORMATION RELATED TO
HONEYWELL'S REQUEST ON SECURITY ORDER RELAXATION,
AS CONDUCTED ON SEPTEMBER 24, 2018
(CAC/DOCKET/EPID: 000224/04003392/L-2018-LLA-0136)

On September 24, 2018, the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) staff and representatives of Honeywell International, Inc. (Honeywell) held a Category 1 meeting to discuss Honeywell's letter, dated April 30, 2018 (Agencywide Documents and Management System Accession Number ML18130A565, (non-public)), regarding relaxation from security order items for good cause during the plant's ready-idle status for its Metropolis Works facility. Specifically, the purpose of the meeting was to discuss and clarify the NRC's draft request for additional information (D-RAI) regarding the request. The NRC staff had previously provided the respective D-RAI questions to Honeywell, via email, on July 19, 2018.

The meeting was closed to the public for observation because security-related information was discussed at this meeting. The meeting was useful for ensuring that the NRC staff's D-RAI questions were clear to Honeywell. Based on the discussion held, Honeywell indicated that it understood the staff's D-RAI questions. In addition, Honeywell stated that, as part of its formal RAI response, it will provide a proposed license condition, related to updating its security order requirements, for NRC review and approval, in the event prior to the facility resumes conversion operations at a future time.
