1. Documentation that you have had training in the radiation safety, regulatory issues, and emergency procedures for yttrium-90 TheraSpheres, and
2. . Documentation that you have had training in the radiation safety, regulatory issues, and emergency procedures for the Nucletron High Dose Rate Remote Afterloader.

This training requirement may be satisfied by completing training that is supervised by a Radiation Safety Officer, authorized medical physicist, or authorized user, as appropriate, who is authorized for the type(s) of use for which the licensee is seeking approval. Please provide this information with a letter signed by management stating that the training has been completed.

Hi Tara,

Correct, Roger Williams does not use TheraSpheres. They use SirTex microspheres, which is similar.

Roger Williams does have an HDR source. However, I was not specifically listed as the RSO for that device, as Radiation Oncology was a Joint Venture and therefore, handled as a separate entity for Linac and HDR use. I only supported the package receipt and leak testing for the source exchanges.
