Subject: Response to NRC Inspection Report and Preliminary White Finding

Reference: Letter from P. Loudon (NRC) to B. Hanson (EGC), Clinton Power Station—  
NRC Inspection Report 05000461/2018051 and Preliminary White Finding,  
dated October 15, 2018 [EA-18-104]

In the referenced letter, the NRC documented a finding concerning a failure to follow procedures that resulted in the unavailability and inoperability of the Division 2 Emergency Diesel Generator (EDG) when it was relied upon for plant safety, which has been preliminarily determined to be a White finding with low to moderate safety significance.

The referenced letter requested verbal and written notification within 10 days of the date of the letter stating Exelon Generation Company, LLC's (EGC) intention to (1) request a Regulatory Conference to present to the NRC EGC's perspective on the facts and assumptions the NRC used to arrive at the finding and assess its significance, or (2) submit EGC's position on the finding to the NRC in writing.

On October 19, 2018, Mr. Brad Kapellas discussed with the NRC EGC's request to attend a Regulatory Conference. This letter provides the written request to attend a Regulatory Conference. In light of the upcoming Thanksgiving holiday, EGC respectfully requests that the Regulatory Conference be held the week of November 26, 2018. As requested in the referenced letter, EGC will submit supporting documentation at least one week prior to the Regulatory Conference.

There are no regulatory commitments contained in this letter.
