Dear Mr. McFadyen:

On September 24 and 25, 2018, the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) conducted an unannounced follow-up inspection regarding a routine inspection conducted in 2017 at your primary hospital facility in Boise, Idaho. The 2018 inspection examined activities conducted under your license as they related to the violations identified in a 2017 inspection (EA-17-181). The closure of the 2017 violations were discussed with you during an exit meeting on September 25, 2018.

The inspection consisted of an examination of the corrective actions taken, review of the root cause analysis and your self-assessment activities, evaluations of related procedures, plans and program documents, observations of required facility changes, interviews with personnel, and independent radiation measurements to ensure shielding was intact after new construction.

Based on the results of this inspection, the NRC has concluded that your corrective actions adequately address the regulatory noncompliance, will prevent recurrence of similar issues, and that full compliance has been restored.

In accordance with Title 10 of the *Code of Federal Regulations* (CFR) 2.390 of the NRC's "Agency Rules of Practice and Procedure," a copy of this letter will be made available electronically for public inspection in the NRC Public Document Room or from the NRC's Agencywide Documents Access Management System (ADAMS), accessible from the NRC Web site at <http://www.nrc.gov/reading-rm/adams.html>.
