By letter dated September 20, 2016 (Agencywide Documents Access and Management System (ADAMS) Accession No. ML16264A454) and supplemented by a letter dated April 19, 2018 (ADAMS Accession No. ML18117A225), Tennessee Valley Authority (TVA, the applicant) submitted a Topical Report (TR), "TVA Overall Basin Probable Maximum Precipitation and Local Intense Precipitation Analysis, Calculation CDQ0000002016000041" for review.
