SUBJECT: TERMINATION OF NRC RADIOACTIVE MATERIALS LICENSE NO. 25-29088-01

By letter dated September 25, 2018, you informed the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) that you wished to terminate your NRC radioactive materials license. The NRC Form 314 dated July 10, 2016, stated that all radioactive material had been transferred to Front Range Nuclear Services (49-27531-01) and Thomas Gray and Associates (CA 2105-30). Transfer records were reviewed during a routine inspection conducted on May 23, 2018.

The supporting documentation to the NRC Form 314 also provided a copy of the latest leak test results. The supporting documentation to the NRC Form 314 stated that the licensee only possessed radioactive materials with radioactive decay half-lives of less than 120 days. A review of the historical file supported that only short lived radioactive materials were possessed by the licensee. The NRC staff has reviewed the supporting documentation to your NRC Form 314. Based on the documentation submitted and a review of your historical file, the staff concluded that all licensable radioactive material has been removed from the facility and the facility located at 600 Highway 91, South, Dillion Montana, 59725, is suitable for unrestricted use in accordance with 10 CFR 20.1402, "Radiological Criteria for Unrestricted Use." Based on these conclusions, no further remediation or actions with respect to NRC regulated material is required.

Please find enclosed Amendment No. 57 to License No. 25-29088-01 authorizing your license termination. An environmental assessment for this action is not required since this action is categorically excluded under 10 CFR 51.22(c)(20)(i).
