Ladies and Gentlemen:

The Defense Health Agency (DHA) intends to apply for a Master Material License (MML) from the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) for oversight of facilities that utilize radioactive material. This action was approved by the DHA Enterprise Solutions Board on October 1, 2018.

The DHA is transitioning over the next four fiscal years, in a phased approach, to assume administration and management of all Department of Defense (DoD) Military Treatment Facilities (MTFs). The establishment of a MML and the training of qualified staff will require time to ensure the program is functional. The DHA will use the current NRC Broad Scope License as a bridging function to obtain an MML over the next couple of years.

The DHA is hereby requesting that the NRC allow the Department of the Navy and the Department of the Air Force, to continue to permit current MTFs under their respective MMLs for a period of two years after the MTF is aligned under the DHA. This will allow for continuity of patient care without reducing services provided to our military beneficiaries.
