Dear Dr. Golub:

By the letter dated August 8, 2018, Cardiology Associates of Central Connecticut, LLC (CACC) and Consulting Cardiologists, P.C. (CC) requested written consent by the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) to a proposed direct transfer of control of CACC's license to CC. From your letter, we understand that this transfer will result from a merger of CACC into CC, and that all operations will continue under the CC name and tax identification number. It is also our understanding that this transfer will not result in any change to the location of use, materials, persons using licensed material, or persons responsible for radiation safety at the licensed facility.


Based on the above understandings, as more fully detailed in the enclosed NRC staff's Safety Evaluation Report, which documents the NRC staff's safety review of the request, the NRC consents to the proposed transfer. Please note that you will need to notify us promptly, in writing, after the transaction has been finalized and include a signed copy of the agreement confirming completion of the transaction. With this information, we can issue an administrative amendment to your NRC license to reflect the transaction. Please notify the NRC in writing, if this planned merger has not been consummated within 30 days of the proposed date of merger, which is expected to occur on January 1, 2019, or the NRC may deem this consent to be null and void. Based on the above understandings, the NRC consents to the proposed direct transfer of control of NRC Materials License No. 06-30842-01. Future changes in the licensee's name, licensed use, licensed materials, licensed location, or persons responsible for licensed material require submission of a request to amend the license. NRC approval must be received prior to implementation of the proposed change.
