Dear Mr. Wassenaar:

In the letter dated October 17, 2018, you requested approval for a transfer of control that would result from a planned internal corporate reorganization whereby Nordion will be merged with its parent company, 8921903 Canada, Inc. and several other non-licensee affiliated companies. In order to continue our review, please provide the following additional information:

1. Please have senior management from 8921903 Canada, Inc. confirm that they concur with all statements and commitments made in the October 17, 2018 letter (ML18298A278).
2. You indicated that the Nordion will be merged with its parent company, 8921903 Canada, Inc. and "several other non-licensee affiliated companies." Please identify what these other non-licensee affiliated companies are, and indicate their relationship with Nordion (Canada) Inc. (i.e. do these companies currently have partial ownership of Nordion (Canada), Inc. or 8921903 Canada, Inc.)? Please also have senior management from these non-licensee affiliated companies confirm that they concur with all statements and commitments made in the October 17, 2018 letter (ML18298A278).
3. Please confirm that the transferor and transferee(s) agree to the conditions of the transfer.
4. Please confirm that the transferee(s) will abide by all constraints, conditions, requirements, representations, and commitments of the transferor or that the transferee(s) will submit a complete description of the proposed licensed program.
5. Describe any planned changes in the organization (i.e. specifically, is there a change in membership of the board of directors).

6. Confirm that there are no changes in the reporting structure between the Radiation Safety Officer and senior management regarding radiation safety and activities authorized by your license.

We will continue our review upon receipt of the requested information. You may respond to my attention in writing by letter, email (if letter is signed by senior management and scanned into a pdf format), or fax (610-337-5269), referencing mail control numbers 610268 and 610285. If we do not receive a reply from you within 30 calendar days from the date of this e-mail, we will assume that you do not wish to pursue your amendment request.
