This refers to a letter dated November 9, 2018 (ML18318A032) requesting the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) release the South Farm facility from the license for unrestricted use. The licensee requested the release in accordance with Title 10 of the *Code of Federal Regulations* (CFR) 10 CFR 30.36.

The NRC will perform a review and will notify you of our completion at a future date. As part of our review, the NRC may request additional information which you may receive in future correspondence.

When a licensee permanently ceases principal activities at a building, outdoor area or site, the NRC considers the facility to transition from operational to decommissioning, for fee-billing purposes, and the fees you will be assessed may change. Please contact the NRC to discuss your plans to decommission your site and the impacts it will have on your fee-billing.

The NRC may perform decommissioning site inspections of your facility at any time prior to NRC approved unrestricted release of a site or outdoor area.
