Orchard, Hiltz & McCliment, Inc. (OHM Advisors) provided an amendment letter request dated November 27, 2018 addressing several changes. We wish to address the additional information requested within this letter following our telephone and email correspondence.


One item was to change the storage location from 2940 Parkview Drive, Petoskey, MI to 300 E. Mitchell, Petoskey, MI. OHM Advisors will provide another amendment request for the removal of the old storage location from our license within 60 days from the location change date.

Another item was to remove the two Seaman Nuclear Corporation Model C-75 gauges from our license. These are the only two Seaman Nuclear Corporation Model C-75 gauges that have been processed under our license. Our latest leak tests are attached as requested.

We understand Ohio is an Agreement State with its own nuclear materials licensing program. OHM Advisors shall contact the Ohio Department of Health directly regarding our interest in using and storing licensed material within the state.


