Dear Dr. Funanage,

This is in reference to your letter dated November 28, 2018, requesting for amendment to Nuclear Regulatory Commission License No. 07-16199-01, Docket No. 03010568. In order to continue our review, we need the following additional information:

1. You have proposed that Dr. Barwe be the Radiation Safety Officer named on the license. NUREG-1556, Volume 7, Rev. 1, "Consolidated Guidance About Materials Licenses Program-Specific Guidance About Academic, Research and Development, and Other Licenses of Limited Scope Including Electron Capture Devices and X-Ray Fluorescence Analyzers," states in section 8.7.1 to present the training and experience using licensed materials of the proposed candidate. You have presented the training of Dr. Barwe but not her specific experience using licensed materials. Please provide the experience using licensed materials (types, forms, quantities handled, activities performed, duration of experience).
2. Your request did not make any request to change license condition 11. This is the list of authorized users and the material that they are authorized. The current Radiation Safety Officer, Robert Mason, Ph.D., is listed as an authorized user. Should Dr. Mason be removed and Dr. Barwe added? If so, is Dr. Barwe being requested to be added for all licensed material or just certain isotopes? Please follow guidance in section 8.7.2 of NUREG-1556, Volume 7, Rev. 1, when responding.

We will continue our review upon receipt of this information. Please reply to my attention at the Region 1 Office (Address below) and refer to Mail Control No. 610746. If you have technical questions regarding this letter, please call me at (610) 337-5366.

Your reply must be an originally signed and dated letter. The letter may be scanned and submitted as a pdf document attached to an email; or it may be transmitted by facsimile to (610) 337-5269; or it may be sent by regular mail. If we do not receive a reply from you within 30 calendar days from the date of this e-mail, we will assume that you do not wish to pursue your application OR amendment request.
